

**GREEN SPIRAL**  
**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
*As amended April 3, 2008*

*Pursuant to the provisions of Act 162, Public Acts of 1982, the undersigned corporation executes the following Articles:*

**ARTICLE I**

The name of this corporation is "Green Spiral".

**ARTICLE II**

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

*Green Spiral exists to provide a structured, readily accessible organization for Pagans at Michigan State University and in the surrounding communities. It is open to people of any age, religion or level of experience.*

*Green Spiral aims to provide a safe place to congregate and meet other student and non-student Pagans. The group holds frequent meetings where people can learn together, share together, and discuss items of relevance in a friendly manner. In addition, members may organize field trips, workshops or other special events. By being actively involved on the campus of MSU, Green Spiral seeks to improve the public perception of people involved in esoteric religions.*

**ARTICLE III**

1. The corporation is organized on a nonstock basis.
2.
  - a. The corporation is to be financed under the following general plan: Membership dues, fundraising, and donations.
  - b. The corporation is organized on a membership basis.

**ARTICLE IV**

## **ARTICLE VI**

1. The officers and directors of the corporation shall be elected by the membership, through procedures set forth in the bylaws, in April of each year for the following Michigan State University academic year.
2. The board of directors shall consist of three individuals. The first seat must not be filled by any person who is not a staff or faculty member of Michigan State University. The holder of this seat shall act as advisor for the Green Spiral registered student organization of Michigan State University, in accordance with university regulations. The second and third seats may be filled by any individual who is both a member of Green Spiral and is not currently an undergraduate student of Michigan State University.

## **ARTICLE VII**

1. Standard Green Spiral membership shall be conferred on a Michigan State University fall and spring semester basis, upon notifying of the treasurer and submitting their contact information and membership fee.
2. Membership shall be revocable as set forth in the corporate bylaws.
